Dear Parents/Guardians:

In March, 2017, the district provided information regarding the results of our first round of lead testing. As indicated in that letter, there were six water outlets that originally contained over the state action level of 15.5 parts per billion. At that time, we immediately addressed the situation and shut off all identified outlets until a second test was completed.

At this time, we have completed the second round of tests and the results have indicated all six outlets are under the state level. Our initial results were higher due to the low or no usage of these outlets.

Below are the results of the six areas after a second round of testing:

- Outside Spigot #1 has less than 1 parts per billion
- Outside Spigot #4 has less than 1 parts per billion
- Kitchen has less than 1 parts per billion
- Room C- 101 #3 has 1.8 ppb - This outlet was turned off permanently and marked as not to be used. This was not a fountain that was used often.
- Room D -101 has 1.3 parts per billion - We are in the process of replacing this fountain.
- Room A -104 has 1.8 parts per billion - We are in the process of replacing this fountain.

Please note:

- Spigot #1, #4, and the kitchen have all been marked as "no drinking, hand wash only".
- Fountains have been ordered and will be replaced as soon as they arrive.
- Once the outlets are replaced, we will test for a third time.
- These six outlets will be tested yearly.

Students are permitted to bring in water bottles from home.
