Participating members of the public are reminded that they must comply with District Policy 0167 – Public Participation in Board Meetings. Comments must be appropriate for a public meeting at which minors and students may be in attendance. The Board will not address email comments which violate District Policy 0167 and/or are inappropriate for discussion at a public meeting.

Email comments will be read by the Board Secretary, or a designee, during the Public Comment portion of the agenda.

The Board asks that you keep your email comments concise and focused, both in length and in scope of topics, so that other members of the public who wish to comment are afforded an opportunity to do so.

While the Board is committed to hearing the public's comments, in the interests of efficiency and so that the Board can proceed with all of the work that must be accomplished during the Special Session meeting, email comments received after the Public Comment portion has been closed will not be read aloud during this meeting.
